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Welcome parents, Guardians, and family to our 2017 Youth football program. In an effort to update you with our current rules of play policies and program we have listed a partial list taken from our rules of play policies, for more on our rules of play policies you may obtain a copy from our website. www.oterocountyyouthfootball.org One of our newly revised polices is to amend a Parent/ Guardian agreement that must be signed and returned to your team mom, should you have any questions regarding our policies please email @ ocyfl@live.com and you will receive an immediate response in accordance with your preference.

- We are a non-profit organization.
- All sponsors are provided with the leagues W-9 tax Identification number, all money donated are tax deductible.
- Our program primary focus is player fundamentals and instructional techniques.
- Prohibits; drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, reflecting mirrors.
- All pets must be attached to a collar, any mess that may come from your pet must be cleaned up by the pet owner.
- Registration fees must be submitted before your child's first game, in the form of a check or money order, there is a \$35.00 return check fee.
- Physicals are a requirement and must be in before your child is able to obtain equipment and begin practicing, all physicals must be physician approved.

Frequent asked questions...

- 1. What does my \$ 75.00 fee cover?** Jerseys \$40.00, Game pants \$20.00, \$15.00 insurance.
 - 2. Who governs the leagues polices?** Because we are Non city, or fellow sports organizations affiliated, we the commission do. The rules of play are assessed each year to see if there are any new policies that need amending or removed etc. all our policies are there to benefit the kids and all stakeholders.
 - 3. Who are stakeholders?** Commissioners, coaches, and Players
- Once a player has been drafted to a team, they are required to stay with said team, there is No switching teams for any reason. Once a player drops they are required to submit all equipment in within a 48 hour time frame.
 - The 2017 Team representative has the same authority as a commissioner, he may hold all stakeholders liable for their actions and polices, all rulings must be ran by the president.

- Parents have the responsibility of providing transportation to and from all practices and games, the league is not liable for the transportation of the kids.
- Your kids must be given attention at all times during practices and games at no time should a player not be worked with during practice. All players must be given 10 plays per quarter.
- All team, coaches and staff complaints have a chain of command the head coach along with the team rep must be made aware of any issues regarding your player however any complaint must take action after practice or game is over.
 - All game day complaints requires a 24 hour waiting process to avoid any confrontation. • There are no league named social media sites permitted. Other than the league.
- Any person(s) involved in slandering a stakeholder on line, published, in public will face suspension. Deformation of character, threats, bullying, damage to personal property.
- All of our coaches are USA football certified to ensure that your child is getting the absolute best teaching techniques.
- All requested commissioner meetings requires 24-48 hour notice
 - At no time is a player to be picked up by the helmet or shoulder pads.
 - At no time is an injured player to be moved until it has been confirmed that they are not hurt.
 - The league insurance does not cover ambulance transportation.
 - All head concussions or suspected head concussions requires a physician's release.
 - All injuries must be reported to the commission.
 - There is no opting out of a coach, the only and accepted feasible reasons are for legal reasons.
 - All volunteers are required to have a background check on file before they are allowed to work with your children.
 - It is imperative that your child is willing to commit to our program, any player who is not willing to work at the sport will not learn, it is important that they listen and participate in games and practice.
 - All complaints must be in written forum, all complaints must be in reference to your child's welfare and or concerns regarding the league. Complaints must be emailed to the league president @ ocyfl@live.com. Any complaint that does not contain a name will not be taken serious. All names are not included in the addressed complaint.
 - All parents and sideline guest are liable for their actions, some behavior can lead to game ejection. If ejected please note that you will be automatically suspending the following game unless otherwise told in following meeting.
 - Any person(s) violating self-control will be asked to leave the fields. If you refuse to leave DPS will be called.
 - All self-made trash is your responsibility to pick up, not picking up after yourself will penalize your team loss of field yardage.

- Although we are not city affiliated we are all required to follow all city parks rules and policies.
- During our football season we do not permit any outside league affiliation.
- Any person(s) condoning intentional player injury will be season suspended. Our policy is to assure that each child is far from harm.
- Sideline coaching is not allowed. It is confusing to the kids when they are being given lessons by their coach.
- Encouragement, celebration, and positive feedback to your child and other children is applauded and accepted. Negative celebration, and negative feedback to your child and other children is Not accepted.
- It is difficult as a game ref to see all infractions on the field, while you have your eyes on your child, our refs have their eyes on all the children please bare with them. If you see something that is not right on the field please refrain from yelling at the refs, rather take your concerns to your coach so he may call for a time out to address the issue.
- If at any time you feel that the environment that you and your children are in are unsafe or unfit, please contact a commissioner immediately.
- All open wound injuries will require a bandage before your child may return to the game. The league does supply a first aid kit.
- At no time are players permitted to use glove adhesive.
- Steel cleats are Not permitted.
- All mouthpieces are required to be attached to the helmets in the exception of dental requirements.
- Person signing this contract please make aware that you are signing for your spectators also so please make sure to inform everyone.
